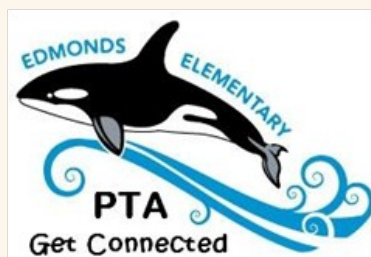

Many thanks to the Edmonds Elementary families, moms and dads, grandparents and kids alike, who have contributed to our school community fundraiser!

We have raised \$14,620 in contributions as of today.

This represents about 60% EE family participation or about 200 out of the 346 children!

WE NEED \$4,800 MORE to meet our goal of 75% participation!

With \$35 of the \$75 request going to cover supply costs, this means that 60% of the families are paying for 100% of the cost of supplies.

Our ORCA-run held last Friday was quite an event and a great way to wind down our fall fundraising campaign. The afternoon event was blessed with no rain. The students had a great time and ran their hearts out. Both big and small together, working toward a common goal to show their spirit and support for our school.

316 students ran 2,709 laps totaling approximately 677 miles! That is an average of 2.25 miles per student.
